CROCHET BUNTING

A step-by-step guide with a handy video recommended by your lead crafters - Hazel & Viv.

For total beginners - we recommend this video by Bella Coco to get familiar with the types of stitches you will need to know.

For advanced, see Hazel's diagrams here.

- 1** Tie a slipknot and insert your hook and chain two. This is your first row.
- 2** For your second row, you're going to do two double crochets into the second chain from hook
- 3** For your third row, turn your work, chain one and then double crochet twice into each of the two stitches. You should now have 4 stitches in your row.
- 4** For your fourth row, turn your work and chain one. Then double crochet twice in the first stitch, and then once in each of the remaining 3 stitches. You should now have 5 stitches in your row.
- 5** For your fifth row, turn your work and chain one. Double crochet twice in the first stitch then once in each of the remaining 4 stitches. You should now have 6 stitches in your row
- 5** Follow the pattern as above until you have as many rows as you desire! Then fasten off and sew in the end of the yarn.
